

Rules for the "REEL in the FUN" Kids' Fishing Tournament

- 1. Registration is required prior to the event. Must be an Ormond Beach resident to register.
- 2. Teams consist of (1) adult and up to (2) children.
- 3. Check-in is 8:00am 8:30am. The tournament shall run from 9:00am to 11:00am. The sounding of the horn will start and finish the tournament. Winners will be awarded after all results are calculated.
- 4. Adult supervision is required for all age groups.
- 5. All fishing rules of the Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission will apply.
- 6. The tournament is catch and release only.
- 7. Contestants are responsible for providing all necessary supplies to fish in the tournament (fishing pole, fishing line, bait, hooks, etc.).
- 8. Adults may help bait hooks, net fish, remove fish, untangle lines, and MAY ASSIST with casting.
- 9. Only one pole in the water at a time per child (contestants can have back-ups ready).
- 10. All anglers must fish from the shoreline.
- 11. Due to the number of participants and close quarters, only live and/or dead bait will be allowed. No casting of lures or artificial bait permitted.
 - 12. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place prizes and awards will be presented for Largest Game Fish in each age category. The largest fish will be determined by weight. *Tiebreaker next largest fish and/or most fish caught will determine winner*.

Age Categories are as follows: Ages 4 - 6 Ages 7 - 9 Ages 10 - 12

- 13. All participants and adult supervisors must show good sportsmanship at all times.
- 14. Please do not leave litter at the fishing site.

Remember this is all about having fun fishing and enjoying your time together!

Parking is limited on site; additional parking is available across the street at Grace Lutheran Church.
